
## Mark 11:7-10

## Jer 29:10-14


After seventy years are completed at Babylon, I will visit you and perform My good word toward you, and cause you to return to this place.

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# The Decrees to "Rebuild"

(1) Cyrus, 537 B.C., Ezra 1:2-4;

(2) Darius, Ezra 6:1-5, 8, 12;

(3) Artaxerxes, 458 B.C,. Ezra 7:11-26;

(4) Artaxerxes, 445 B.C., Neh 2:5-8, 17, 18.

Commands (1), (2), & (3): were to build the Temple.

Only (4) was to rebuild the city, the walls, etc.

2:6 .. So it pleased the king to send me; and I set him a time.



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
