

THE CAPTIVITY OF JUDAH 2 Chron, 36: 11-21.


2 Kings 25:8-21; 2 Chronicles 36:17-21

- Took all the articles from the house of God, the treasures of the king and of his leaders.
- Burned the house of God, all the king's palaces, all houses in Jerusalem.
- Broke down the wall of Jerusalem.
- Carried the people to Babylon to serve the king of Babylon.

- ²² In the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, in order to fulfill the word of the LORD spoken by Jeremiah, the LORD moved the heart of Cyrus king of Persia to make a proclamation throughout his realm and also to put it in writing:
- ²³ "This is what Cyrus king of Persia says:


Isaiah tells of Cyrus the Great

The author of the second part of the book of Isaiah referred to Cyrus the Great, the conquering hero and architect of the Persian Empire, as a Messiah.




"This is what the LORD says to his anointed (meshiach: messiah)



Ezra 4 - Opposition

- "The enemies of Judah" were the Samaritans.
- The Samaritans were pagans who copied the worship of the Jews.
- They saw God as simply a local "god" of the land who required sacrifices. They did not know or have the Law of Moses.
- They wanted to share in the rebuilding of the Temple. The Jewish leaders refused because they knew nothing of the Law and the true God of heaven and earth.

Ezra 5: The Call of God


